ROAD SAFETY

Road Safety pertains to the measures taken to reduce the risk of road traffic injuries and death

THE ROAD SAFETY SITUATION IN KENYA

- Estimated 3,000 deaths from road crashes occur annually in Kenya
- About 40% are pedestrians.
- ♦ Leading cause of death for young people in the age of between 15-29 years.
- The annual economic cost of road crashes is about 3-5% of the GDP or Kshs.
 300 billion.
- Road crashes are the highest contributors to disability in Kenya, health burden, poverty through loss of able breadwinners.

CAUSES OF ROAD CRASHES IN KENYA

- Driver behavior-speeding, careless driving, drunk driving/ Riding, fatigued driving, distracted driving, aggressive driving, etc
- Motor vehicle related issuesroadworthiness, vehicle inspection and serviceability
- Road infrastructure issues. Black spots due to poor road designs; lack of signage, road markings, road lightings, etc
- Pedestrian issues. Insufficient NMTS facilities. i.e. Pathway for pedestrians and cylists
- Coordination and management issues. Coordination, collaboration and cooperation among the key players remains critical

IMPACT OF ROAD TRAFFIC CRASHES

- Severe stress while others are traumatized
- ♦ Temporarily or permanent disability
- Poverty in households as a result of the deaths of bread winners
- ♦ High cost of medical services borne by GoK on victims.
